Ambitious Danish Presidency programme for transport presented at the European Parliament

Minister for Transport, Mr. Henrik Dam Kristensen, presented the Danish Presidency programme for transport on 24 January 2012 to the European Parliament's Committee on Transport and Tourism.

The Danish Presidency will put special focus on four items. These are the recast of the Single European Railway Area, the revision of the TEN-T guidelines, the Airports package and the proposal for a regulation on the implementation and exploitation of the European satellite navigation systems, Galileo and Egnos.
